THE CONNECTION BETWEEN ERCP AND EUS THROUGHOUT THE COURSE OF TREATMENT

(EUS) endoscopic Endoscopic ultrasound and retroarade cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) are "brother in arm" in the investigation and management of pancreatico-biliary diseases. can be a pre-screening test to ERCP to ensure the indication is correct and minimize the risks of ERCP. Both procedures can complimentary and be performed in the same session, facilitating the diagnosis and treatment of obstructive pancreatico-biliary diseases. More importantly, EUS has gradually developed into a therapeutic technique that requires skills and devices that utilize in ERCP. expanding the field of interventional EUS including EUS-guided biliary and gallbladder drainage, peri-pancreatic collection drainage and even gastro-enterostomy. Thus, to be a competent pancreatico-biliary endoscopist, training program must integrate the skills and knowledge from both procedures. This lecture will outline the "connection between EUS and ERCP" in the management of pancreatico-biliary diseases.
