

CHALLENGES IN DIAGNOSING EARLY COLON CANCER AND HOW TO OVERCOME

The number of colorectal cancer deaths continues to increase not only in Japan but also in Vietnam. Under these circumstances, the demand for colonoscopy is increasing, and it is required to detect lesions, accurately diagnose findings, and select appropriate treatment.

In this lecture, I will explain the most important diagnosis of colorectal epithelial tumors by normal observation and magnified observation, distinguishing between benign and malignant lesions, and determining the treatment plan, especially focusing on normal observation.
